VOLUNTEER POLICIES

- Volunteers must be at least 21 years old as of January 1, 2016.
- Volunteer roles include no monetary compensation.
- Volunteers must reside in Encinitas or the surrounding communities.
- Failure to perform duties as expected/required may result in dismissal from the Volunteer Program and will affect future placement in the volunteer program.
- Volunteers must complete festival volunteer assignment in a satisfactory way (reporting on time for shifts, staying the entire shift, reporting for all shifts, wearing assigned volunteer identification during shift, respecting other volunteers, staff, performers, and patrons of the festival).
- Use of alcohol and/or controlled substances before or while on duty is strictly prohibited. Violators will be subject to immediate dismissal from the Volunteer Program.
- Missing an assigned shift or shifts (or not completing a shift) will jeopardize participation as an Encinitas Foodie Fest volunteer in the future. Note: Every selected volunteer will be given a chance to back out of their assignment prior to the event.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the general volunteer requirements outlined in the volunteer program overview, volunteers must:

- Be able to quickly learn answers to typical questions and give out accurate directions. Your team lead will help prep you on-site and reference materials (maps, etc.) will be provided to you.
- Be outgoing, friendly, and professional. Smile and enjoy your role. You are part of a unique and fun Festival.
- Have strong communication skills and a positive attitude while interacting with staff, other volunteers, patrons, and possibly chefs.
- Be flexible. You might get asked to pitch in for another area if needed.
- Maintain a calm and professional attitude around celebrity chefs and festival staff.
- Must be willing and able to do some light lifting throughout the day. Tasks such as stacking chairs, replenish water coolers, etc. may be requested.
- Must be respectful of presenting chefs and help reinforce courteous behavior while chefs are presenting.

THE PERKS

- The biggest perk is free entry into the festival! After your volunteer shift, you are free to enjoy the event. Some shifts are longer than others, so talk to the volunteer coordinator about arranging a break schedule. If your shift begins mid-day, you can check in early to receive your credential and enjoy the Festival. YOU MUST still return to the volunteer check-in at your designated call time, or you will be counted as a no-show.
- You'll also get a limited edition volunteer t-shirt to wear while you're on shift and to keep as a memento of your contribution to the Festival.
- The festival will provide water.
- You'll be part of a team that's putting on a one of a kind event. It's a fun way to meet people with shared interests and you'll have the satisfaction of knowing you were a big part of making the festival happen.
